
## **BOOKSHELF**

The President of the Italian Astrophilatelic Society AS.IT.AF (Associazione Italiana Astrofilatelia), Umberto Cavallaro, has published a new book on the history of the Race to the Moon.

This is the Story of Puffery vs. the Pragmatic in the race to the Moon between the United States and Russia in the sixties of past century.

The book covers the story from the first triggers from Sputnik over the Man in Space for both countries, to the changed directions in the space race. When the astronaut sits in the driver's seat, technological developments are big, until two tragedies block the race in space. The final leap is of course the landing of two astronauts on the Moon and safely returning home. The last chapter talks about the philatelic side of Apollo 11 and the Insurance Covers.
