



15 Years of Associazione Italiana Astrofilatelia (ASITAF)

The Associazione Italiana Astrofilatelia (Italian Association of Astrophilately) is an organisation that brings together individuals with a passion for both space exploration and philately. The association was founded in 2008 by a group of Italian collectors who wanted to promote the study and collection of stamps related to astronomy, space exploration, and aeronautics.

Astrophilately, is a specialised area of space philately that focuses on covers, and other items related to the history of space exploration. It is a fascinating hobby that combines the worlds of science and art, allowing collectors to learn about the history of space exploration while appreciating the beauty of the stamps themselves.

The Italian Association of Astrophilately has members from all over Italy, as well as members from other countries.
